



Social Distancing Measures at Blakehurst OSHC

5th June 2020

Dear Parents,

We are delighted to welcome our Blakehurst and Bald Face families back to our Blakehurst OSHC Service from Tuesday 9th June and we thank you for accommodating our short term relocation to Carlton South PS over recent weeks.

We have outlined below the new measures which our team will be implementing to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our educators, children and you as parents when visiting our site.

- When dropping off or collecting your child, please do so from the door of the OSHC service, parents are not permitted into the classroom. Your child's arrival/departure will be acknowledged by an Educator who will sign them into/out of our care via the QK Kiosk.
- Temperature checking - each child will have their temperature checked upon arrival at the Service each morning and afternoon. If their temperature reads 37.5°C or above, we will require you to collect your child and return only when clear from fever for 48 hours.
- Maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other people when dropping off and collecting your child.

Feeling Sick? – Please Stay At Home.

Anyone who has potential coronavirus (COVID19) symptoms must not attend the Service until they have obtained medical advice as to their best course of action. There are to be NO exceptions to this. Some symptoms include:

- Fever
- Flu-like symptoms such as coughing, sore throat and fatigue
- Shortness of breath.
